

HAPPY HOLIDAYS

Have a merry time designing and printing all your holiday greeting cards, gift wraps and tags with SPEEDBALL. You can print on white and color papers, cards you can buy at art supply stores, even metallic foils. **IMPORTANT:** Before starting this or any project, be sure to read and understand the directions in the enclosed booklet, "SPEEDBALL Screen Printing Instructions."

1. Use the patterns supplied below or design your own holiday theme. To enlarge or reduce the patterns for greeting cards, gift wraps and tags, take them to a copying center.
2. Transfer your designs to stencil paper. While most any paper will do, one with a coated or shiny surface will last longer.
3. Using an X-ACTO® No. 1 knife with No. 16 stencil blade or scissors, cut out the traced pattern. Be careful not to tear the paper or leave ragged edges.
4. If you are printing more than one color, block out the areas of the stencil you do not wish to print with paper or masking tape placed between the bottom side of the screen fabric and the stencil. Another method is to prepare and cut separate stencils for each color.

Then, just follow the directions on pages 5 and 6 of your "SPEEDBALL Screen Printing Instructions" booklet for applying ink to your screen and printing your design!

HINT: For added accents of color or to personalize your holiday messages, try SPEEDBALL Painters™ Paint Markers.



ADVANCED METHODS FOR PREPARING ARTWORK: You may also try using SPEEDBALL Drawing Fluid/Screen Filler Method or Photographic Emulsion Method. See your "SPEEDBALL Screen Printing Instructions" for details about each of these methods.
