



This Year,
Decorate your
Easter Eggs
with
Simple Leaf™



Have fun this year decorating your home with these beautiful Metal Leaf Eggs!

Follow these easy steps to create your own eggs:

MATERIALS NEEDED

1. *Mona Lisa® Simple Leaf™*
2. *Mona Lisa® Spray Adhesive™*
3. *Paper/ Cardboard eggs*
4. *Plastic bag or trash bag*



STEP 1

Lay the egg on a piece of plastic. (You can use a trash bag, grocery bag or even a sandwich bag) Then spray your egg with Mona Lisa Spray Adhesive. Allow it to sit for 2 -5 minutes.



STEP 2

Once your egg is tacky you are ready to leaf your egg. Hold 1 sheet of Simple Leaf™ in the palm of your hand. Then place the egg in the center of the leaf.



STEP 3

Using 2 hands start to form the leaf around the egg. Try to avoid touching the egg with the plastic backing of the leaf. Continue to roll the egg in your hand as if you were forming a snowball. Do not worry if you have wrinkles in your paper, you can touch up these areas in step 4.



STEP 4

Now that your egg is fully covered you can now start to un-wrap your egg. As you pull the plastic backing off the leaf you may see areas that did not get covered due to a wrinkle in the paper. **NO WORRIES** if you see any extra leaf on your paper just press it onto a tacky area that needs leaf!



STEP 5

Once you have removed the plastic backing, roll the egg around in your hand to smoothen out the leaf.

You now have a beautiful Metal Leafed egg!
